PROFESSIONAL CAREER INTERNSHIP

Linton-Stockton High School offers an Internship Program that is designed for senior students who want to explore specific, targeted career objectives through workplace experience. Our March student Employee of the Month is Audrey Elliott and she has written about her experience this year.

Audrey Elliott

My name is Audrey Elliott, and I am currently a Senior at Linton Stockton High School. I am 17 years old, and I have three sisters. I have been in band since I was in the fifth grade, and I have been drum majorette for my junior and senior years of high school. I am also the Vice President of the National Honor Society. I plan to attend either Vincennes University or Indiana State University to get my Bachelor's Degree in Business. I am not sure what I will do with my degree yet, but I have many options.

Last semester, I interned at ProMark Building Solutions located behind Walmart in Linton. I interned in the financial department, and I had my own office. I completed sales tax reports and transferred coils to flats in the computer. I loved being at ProMark! In fact, I was offered a job there this summer and plan to take it.

CURRENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

1) **Indiana Fraternal Order of Police Scholarship** – Must be an immediate relative (son, daughter, stepson or stepdaughter) of an active or retired FOP member. **All applications must be mailed and postmarked by March 1, 2019.** Hand delivered applications will not be accepted. 2) **Bedford Board of Realtors Scholarship** – **Application deadline is March 15, 2019.** Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded. Student must be the child or grandchild or legal guardian of a primary/secondary member of the Bedford Board of Realtors. Stop by the guidance office for additional information.

3) **Crane Credit Union Scholarship** – \$1,000 scholarship. **Deadline March 1st.** Eligibility requirements include membership of CCU in good standing as a primary account holder, intent to enroll as a full-time student, in the fall, following spring graduation, and minimum GPA of 2.0.

4) **The American Legion Auxiliary** has several scholarship opportunities. Stop by the guidance office or go to the website www.alaforveterans.org. Click on the scholarship tab to view and print.

5) **Greene County Foundation General Scholarships for high school seniors** – Several scholarships are open to seniors from any Greene County high school, plus a few that are exclusive to each school. **Application deadline is Fri., March 15th at 11:59 PM.** To apply, visit the Community Force Scholarship portal at: <https://greenecountyfoundation.communityforce.com/Login.aspx>. 6) **IAG Scholarship Competition 2019** – Indiana Association for the Gifted Scholarship is \$2,000. Go to IAG Scholarship 2019 for more information. **Submission deadline is March 20, 2019.**

7) **Jaden Lauderdale Memorial Scholarship** – Applicants should be seniors of a public Greene County School and be pursuing a career in the medical field. **Application should be mailed and postmark must be March 22, 2019, or before.**

8) **PACE / Judith K. Bobe Scholarship** - \$500 scholarship, one-time award. The applicant must have been enrolled in the Head Start Program in the Indiana Counties of Daviess, Greene, Knox, or Sullivan. Applications are available in the guidance office. All Materials must be received – NOT postmarked – **by PACE no later than March 29, 2019.**

9) **Veterans’ Memorial 2019 Scholarship** - \$1,000 scholarship to one (1) 2019 Greene County high school senior. Submit a typed essay (750 – 1000 words) on: **“Should the USA have Mandatory Military or Public Service of a 2-year Commitment for Everyone, Ages 18-26?” Include Pros and Cons.** Must be submitted to the Greene County Veterans’ Office in Bloomfield by **Monday, April 1st at 4:00 PM.** Applications are available in the guidance office or go online at the Greene County Foundation website and look under scholarship applications.

10) **Physicians of Greene County Scholarship** - \$500 scholarship to a student interested in or pursuing a career in healthcare. Applications are available in the guidance office and must be **completed and returned to Greene County General Hospital by April 1, 2019.**

11) **Dr. Mathias Mount Memorial Scholarship** – Greene County General Hospital will award two scholarships in the amount of \$1,062.00 in memory of Dr. Mathias Mount and Eleanor C. Mount. Seniors enrolled in a Greene County high school and interested in pursuing a career in healthcare are eligible to apply. Applications are available in the guidance office and can be **mailed or delivered to Greene County General Hospital by April 1, 2019.**

12) **The American Legion Scholarship** – Applications are available in the high school guidance office and **the deadline is April 2, 2019.** Two scholarships will be awarded. Applicants will be judged on scholastic achievement with a minimum GPA of 3.0, leadership and financial need.

13) **Beecher Family Scholarship** – This scholarship is for a L-SHS senior planning to enroll as a full-time student in the fall of 2019. Must have a 3.0 GPA, **Deadline in April 5th, 2019, at 3:05 PM**

14) **James M. Brown Scholarship** – Eligibility for this scholarship includes: Top 10 of the graduating class, an 8 semester GPA of 3.5 or above, attended all 8 semesters of high school at L-SHS, earned 2 credits in a dual credit or AP class, and submit this online form by the **deadline of Friday, April 5th, 2019 at 3:00 PM.**

15) **Tim Deeter Scholarship** – This scholarship will be awarded to a student from L-SHS who intends to go into any automotive trade. If there is no eligible student in the aforementioned category, the scholarship may be awarded to a band student with the highest GPA, excluding students ranked in the top 10 of the senior class. **Deadline for this application is April 5th, 2019 at 3:05 PM.**

16) **L-SHS Class of 1961 Memorial Scholarship** – Applicant must be a full-time graduating senior, have attended Linton-Stockton High School all four years of high school, plan to enroll as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution, and have a minimum GPA of 2.333 (C+ average or better). Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline is April 5, 2019, at 3:05 PM.**

17) **Phil Harris Scholarships** - Applicants must be a full-time Linton-Stockton High School graduating senior and plan to enroll as a full-time student at a four-year college or university (3.0 minimum GPA) or at Vincennes University (2.0 minimum GPA) for the fall of 2019. **Application deadline is April 5th, 2019 at 3:05 PM in the Guidance Office.**

18) **\$500 STEM Scholarship** – This application is to be printed and emailed to winupin@gmail.com and the **deadline for submission is April 5, 2019 at 5:00 PM ET.** Current Indiana High School seniors or current Indiana College students are eligible to apply.

19) **Beta Sigma Phi Scholarship** – Two \$500 awards will be awarded to Linton seniors. No area of study specified. Applications are available in the guidance office with a **deadline of April 10, 2019.**

20) **Greene County Master Gardeners** – This scholarship is intended for Agriculture / Horticulture majors only. Applications are available in the guidance office and must be mailed to the address on the application and have a **deadline of April 15, 2019.**

21) **Tri Kappa Scholarship (Vocational / \$500)** – Applications are available in the guidance office and have a **deadline of April 19, 2019**. This scholarship is intended for students entering a vocational area or trade.

22) **Tri Kappa Scholarship (Academic / \$700)** – This scholarship is intended for students seeking a four-year degree in a field of their choice. Applications are available in the guidance office and have a **deadline of April 19, 2019**.

22) **Evan Sipes Memorial Scholarship** – This scholarship is awarded to a student from Linton-Stockton or White River Valley High School. The applicant should intend to pursue a career in the automotive field or a vocational trade. **The application deadline is April 26th, 2019**.

22) **Dale French Scholarship** - \$500 to a student who is pursuing an art education or art-related degree. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Scholarship Deadline is May 1st**.

23) **Indiana APWA Scholarship** – The American Public Works Association (APWA) is sponsoring a scholarship for candidates pursuing a degree in related Public Works fields including but not exclusively in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, or Public Works Management. The amount of the award is to be \$1,000 per year up to 4 years of college. **Applications must be emailed by May 8, 2019** to: Angela.erpelding@cityoffortwayne.org.

24) **Greene County Farm Bureau Scholarship** – Parent(s) must be a member of Indiana Farm Bureau for a minimum of two consecutive years prior to the completion of this application. **Application is due by 12:00 noon, May 15, 2019, by email or delivered to Greene County Farm Bureau in Bloomfield.**

25) **Merl & Maxine Brown Scholarship Trust** – Candidates for this scholarship should be seniors at Linton-Stockton High School or White River Valley High School and have applied or be enrolled in a four-year college or university as a full time student in the fall of 2019. **Applications should be mailed to the address on the application no later than 4:00 PM on Wednesday, May 15th, 2019.**

26) **Linton Freedom Festival Scholarship** - \$500 Scholarship to the winner and \$200 Scholarship to the 1st runner up. Applications are available March 1st in the guidance office for young ladies age 17 to 20 to compete for the title of Freedom Festival Queen and younger ladies, age 13 to 16, to compete for the title of Freedom Festival Princess. Applications should be completed and returned by **Friday, April 19th, 2019**. The actual pageant will take place in June.

27) **BigSun Scholarship** – Big Sun Organization helps young athletes succeed in their academic pursuits. Must be a high school senior or be attending a post secondary institute and currently involved in some sport at the institution or in the community. Award is \$500 and the **deadline is June 19, 2019**.
