Dorothy Wurst Porter Scholarship Fund

Eligibility requires that:

- You are a student from the Wabash Valley
- You intend to pursue a liberal arts major at a private liberal arts institution.
- You demonstrate academic achievement, financial need and involvement in extracurricular activities.

James F. Jackson Scholarship

Eligibility requires that:

- You are a resident of Vigo, Sullivan, Knox or Greene County, Indiana, or of Crawford County, Illinois.
- Preference given to students demonstrating excellence in the areas of math and science.
- You are well-read in the area of non-fiction books/publications.

Lavelda M. Goble Scholarship

Eligibility requires that:

- You are a graduate of Linton-Stockton school system in Greene County, Indiana.

Rex Buntain Tribune Star Scholarship

Eligibility requires that:

- You intend to pursue a career in journalism, preferably print or online journalism.
- Your high school resume and transcript demonstrate an aptitude for success in journalism.
- You are a resident of Clay, Greene, Parke, Sullivan, Vermillion or Vigo County in Indiana, or Clark, Crawford, or Edgar County in Illinois.

Wabash Valley Mechanical Contractors Scholarship

Eligibility requires that:

- You are a current high school senior or current college student.
- You live in one of the following counties served by the Wabash Valley Mechanical Contractors Association: in Indiana - Benton, Carroll, Clay, Clinton, Fountain, Greene, Montgomery, Parke, Putnam, Sullivan, Tippecanoe, Vermillion, Vigo and Warren and in Illinois - Clark, Crawford, Douglas, Edgar, Richland and Vermilion.
- You are pursuing - or intend to pursue - a degree in the mechanical construction field, such as engineering or construction management, or a field related to mechanical construction.
